



# Dog Daycare Information

## What is dog daycare at Cape Cod Pet Resort?

Our mission is to provide your dog with a safe and healthy play environment to enrich their spirit and increase their social skills, offer an off-leash area to exercise their body and give hours of play to stimulate their mind. Supervised by caring staff members, our daycare offers an educational alternative to being left home alone, with exercise, socialization and opportunities to learn new skills, while interacting with other dogs.

## What is the Value of daycare at Cape Cod Pet Resort for your dog?

- Off-leash play
- Lots of exercise
- Burning off energy (for a calmer, mellower dog)

## Drop In and Play, Anytime

At Cape Cod Pet Resort we provide the best environment for your dog to socialize and feel safe. Our playful environment is a result of dogs getting to know each other during repeated visits. This occurs by reducing the stress of meeting new and unfamiliar dogs every day, no different from the increased comfort level you feel once you become more familiar with new friends.

## Daycare Overview

Your dog can be dropped off at the Cape Cod Pet Resort between 7:00 – 9:30 a.m. Monday thru Friday and after 9am on Saturday(July-August). Pick up times are between 3:30 – 5:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday and before 4:00pm on Saturday(July-August). (If you need an earlier drop off or later pick up, please ask about options). Your dog's day will consist of supervised play on agility equipment, jumping in and out of cool pools of water (during warm weather), or just running around with friends and playing with our staff and fun toys.

Our daycare facility offers 1200 square feet of indoor space and 1200 square feet of outdoor space. The indoor area is equipped with ¾" Tenderfoot flooring for cushioning your dog's playing.

## Your Dog's First Day

Your dog needs to be dropped off first thing in the morning to reduce the stress of meeting the other dogs. In the afternoon, we ask that new dogs are the first ones to be picked up (to reduce the stress of seeing other dogs leave first).

# Requirements

## ***Before your dog comes to play:***

In order for your dog to come to day care, these steps need to be completed. When your dog is approved for daycare, we can set a start date.

1. Call for a temperament test, see the daycare and meet our staff.
2. Complete the Application for Dog Day Care and a New Client Information Form and either bring the forms in with you or fax to: 508-564-4757.
3. Provide CCPR with your veterinarian's copy of your dogs' vaccination records.

## ***Other Basic Requirements***

**Age:** 3 months or older

**Sex:** Spayed/neutered over 6 month of age

**Shots:** Bordatella (kennel cough), DHLPP (distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parainfluenza and parvovirus) and rabies vaccines. Canine Influenza vaccine not required but strongly recommended.

**Health:** A negative result on a recent fecal test (within 6 months) is required. If it has been over 6 months, we can do the test for your pet.

**Behavior:** All dogs must be non-aggressive towards dogs and humans.

**Collars/Harnesses:** All dogs must have a quick release collar with name tag. You can purchase collars and name tags at our retail store for \$10.00.

## Screening process

All dogs must pass a temperament test to assure that they are both dog and people-friendly. It is important for the health and safety of all concerned that the dogs attending daycare do not have aggressive tendencies, be food or toy possessive or be overly protective of territory.
